Since the 'Everyone In' directive on March 26th...

120 **1** We have helped place 120 people into accommodation who would otherwise be homeless, so that they could safely self-isolate.

We have helped facilitate the move-on of 24 people into more appropriate accommodation.

87 volunteers have worked 881 hours helping clean our buildings and delivering meals to vulnerable clients during lockdown - an equivalent saving of £9,471*
